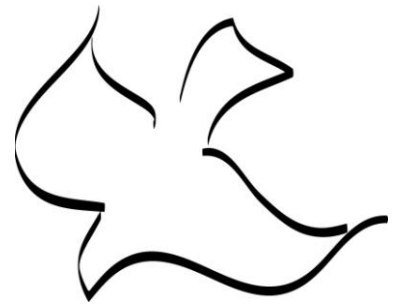

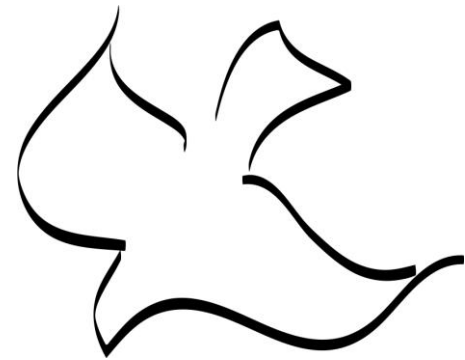


Levenshulme Remembers
