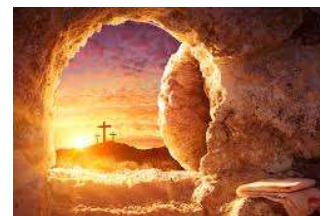

Holy week is such a mixture of emotions:

Jesus makes a triumphal entry to Jerusalem. The crowds at the side of the road shouting 'Hosanna to the Son of David!' – Mt 21.9

Jesus' anger in the Temple to see the moneychangers, turning over the tables saying "My house shall be called a house of prayer". – Mt 21.13

The plot to kill Jesus 'You know that after two days the Passover is coming, and the Son of Man will be handed over to be crucified.' – Mt 26.2

The fellowship of the Last Supper, 'Take, eat; this is my body.' – Mt 26.26

The betrayal in the garden of Gethsemane, 'Get up, let us be going. See, my betrayer is at hand.' – Mt 26.46

The arrest of Jesus, 'The one I will kiss is the man; arrest him.' – Mt 26.48

Peter's denial of knowing Jesus, 'I do not know the man!' At that moment the cock crowed.' – Mt 26.74

The trial with Pilate saying, 'I am innocent of this man's blood; see to it yourselves.' – Mt 27.24

The crucifixion, 'My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?' – Mt 27.46

The glorious resurrection, 'He is not here; for he has been raised, as he said' – Mt 28.6
